Thank you to the PTA for organising such a fabulous disco. It was very successful. So many of the children had dressed up and there were so many witches and monsters in school. Very Spooky.

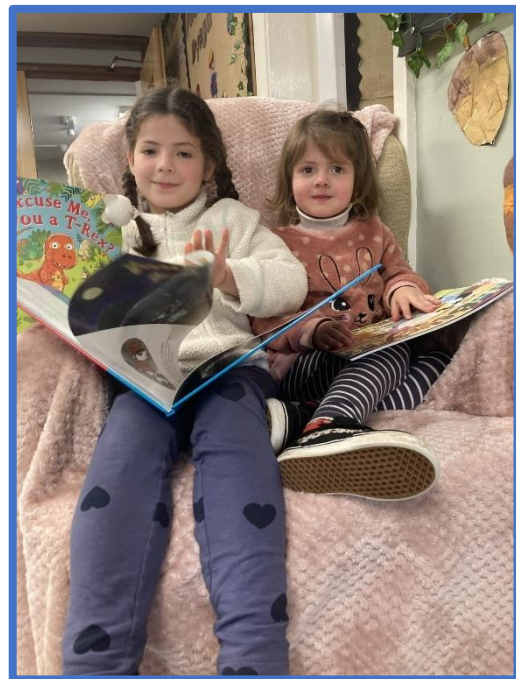
PC Mark Jones
